Sick Calls: If you or someone you know is hospitalized or homebound and would like Communion and/or the Sacrament of the Sick, please call the rectory.

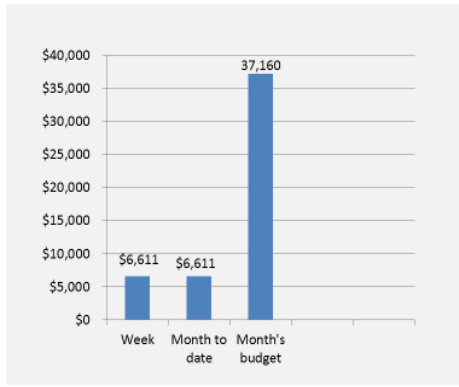

CHURCH CEILING –It’s hard to miss the section of ceiling that is missing in the church! It gave way due to “heat buckling,” the age of the ceiling itself, and improper installation some 60 years ago. The repair of the entire church ceiling will begin this Monday, and will take at least a full week to complete. The 11:30 weekday Mass will be celebrated in the Rectory Living Room during the construction, and the church will be closed; however, the adoration chapel, as always, will be accessible.

RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults)
