CHANGES IN THE SANCTUARY AND CHURCH

– Changes in the Sanctuary and church – Several people have asked about the recent changes in the sanctuary and church. Most comments have been positive, a few not so positive. For the past 2 years at the beginning of each summer we have repeatedly asked for volunteers to either become “project managers” or assist in helping with various projects meant to update and improve our facilities and worship space. Many thanks those who volunteered their time, expertise and resources to make the changes possible. The changes were guided not only by safety and ADA regulations, but also by the needs of parish liturgical life. Among the changes: retrofitting the entire church ceiling, new carpeting throughout the church, repair of the sanctuary floor and installation of hardwood flooring, new laminate flooring in the church entryway and sacristy, restoration of the sanctuary baldachino, installation of an ADA ramp into the sanctuary/adoration chapel, doors with translucent glass installed on the confessional, suspension of the crucifix over the altar, installation of the Our Lady of Victory tapestry in the sanctuary. Again, many, many thanks to those who have helped make these improvements happen!
