OUR LADY OF VICTORY RECEIVED A GRANT TO MITIGATE STORM WATER RUNOFF

Our Lady of Victory was awarded a River Smart Communities Program grant from the Anacostia Watershed Society (AWS) and the District of Columbia's Department of Energy and Environment (DOEE) to install permeable pavers. Permeable pavers (like we have in the first half of the driveway from Whitehaven) will help mitigate stormwater runoff, improve safety, and improve access to the community. Faculty, staff, Clergy NS members of the Palisades community will be able to safely walk in the back of the Church, Parish office and the School by mitigating the overflow of water (and in the Winter, ice) coming down from the development above OLV. The selection committee felt that our application was "thoughtful, comprehensive, and falls well within the scope of the RiverSmart Communities program's goals and objectives" which included letters of support from several faculty and parishioners.

We are very thankful to all the support we received during the process and look forward to keeping everyone informed during the next several months. The first step is a detailed site inspection by DOEE and AWS. Afterwards, bids for installation will be sent out and installation should be completed towards the end of the year or early 2021 (depending on weather.) We are also thankful to the application team of Michelle and Brian Vassallo, Daniel Stockmal, Jim Stockmal, and Ellen Kollar.

Mitigating stormwater run-off is just another part of OLV fulfilling Pope Francis's Laudato Si – Caring for God's Creation – call to action. It is OLV's mission to tend to the environment.
